### Travel:

Imperial College, London, can be arrived at from London Heathrow Airport, via the Underground(UG) , namely, The Piccadilly Line. It will take some 45 minutes, then stop and alight at South Kensington station. Or, from Gatwick Airport, take the Gatwick Express to Victoria Station, there, alight and join London UG District Line, via Paddington, again, alight at South Kensington Station, then walk to Imperial College. At reasonable walking pace, it is about 5 minutes.
